EXAMINATION: THE REPORT

Students have to deliver the report based on the calculations.

There are 3 possible deadlines to present the report:

- Maximum 11 February at 23.59 for the students who want to take the exam in the winter period (January-February)
- One deadline in June (to be decided) for the students who want to take the exam in the summer period (June-July)
- One deadline in September (to be decided) for the students who want to take the exam in the summer period (September-October)

The report has to be uploaded in moodle – the report delivered in other ways will not be considered

EXAMINATION: THE RULES

- Exams will be only in presence.
