



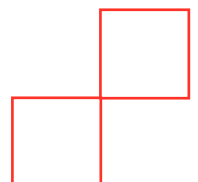

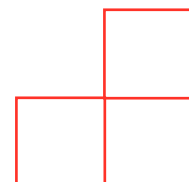

APPLICATION STEPS

NOMINATION	Students cannot apply by themselves, they must be nominated by their International Office by email to international.valencia@universidadeuropea.es Semester 1: April 1 st to April 30 th 2021 Semester 2: September 1 st to September 30 th 2021 Dentistry, Nursing and Physiotherapy internships: Nominations for the whole academic year must be done before May 30 th 2021
ONLINE APPLICATION	Once nominated, students will receive a confirmation from our International Office, together with an incoming student guide and a link to do their online application on our MoveOn platform. Semester 1: May 1 st to May 31 st 2021 Semester 2: October 1 st to October 31 st 2021 <u>Students do not select their classes at this step.</u>
ACCEPTATION	Once their application completed, students will receive the list of classes and are assigned an International tutor to manage their academic questions. WARNING: chosen classes before the stay can be modified during the first week of the stay, due to last minute timetable modifications.

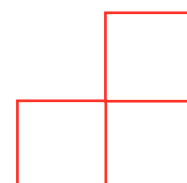

COURSES SELECTION

ECTS	<p>There is a maximum number of ECTS credits that can be selected depending on the duration of stay at UE Valencia</p> <p>1 Semester: 30 ECTS 2 Semesters: 60 ECTS</p> <p>One subject usually represents 6ECTS, meaning students can choose 5 subjects per semester. We will ask student to also give two optional classes in case there is no places left in their first choice.</p>
Language classes	UEV offers online English and Spanish classes (level A1, A2,B1 and B2) Registration for those classes are made during the first weeks of the stay via the webpage of the university.
English classes	<p>UEV offers 5 English teaching degrees:</p> <p>Business International Relations Dentistry Translation Tourism management</p> <p>Due to the high demand on those programs, we cannot guarantee seats in those English classes and students may have no other option than following the Spanish equivalent. That is why a B2 in Spanish is highly recommended.</p>
Internships	<p>The Career Department in UEV publishes internships offers in our internal platform. Exchange students have access to this platform and can apply to internships like any other UEV student. The university can manage the internship agreement.</p> <p>Except for Nursing and Physiotherapy internships provided in one of our partner clinics, for other areas the student is responsible to find, choose and get employed by a company.</p>





TRAVEL ACCOMODATION

Visa Requirements	Compulsory for non-EU students, please check your student's visa requirements at the Spanish Embassy or Consulate in your home Country. Please also check COVID instructions to enter Spain.
Health Insurance	Students are responsible for obtaining International health insurance valid throughout their stay in Spain/Europe. They must provide the International Office with a copy of their insurance at their arrival. We do recommend an insurance company in our guide for incoming students
